'NO AEROSOL' POLICY

Rationale

Approximately 1 in 10 people have asthma - so it's likely that in any change room or classroom there will be someone who will be affected. Aerosol sprays can act as a trigger to a serious asthma attack, or bring on a severe migraine in a sensitive individual. In some cases the allergy can be sufficiently serious to put an individual into anaphylactic shock.

Policy Statement

Marian Catholic College is a 'No Aerosol' school. Aerosol sprays are banned from the college. This ban relates to all aspects of school including excursions, camps/retreats, sports etc.

Breaches of the 'No Aerosol' Policy

Students who are found to be in possession of an aerosol will have it confiscated immediately.

The spray can be collected by the student's parent/carer within a week of confiscation otherwise it will be disposed of.

Your hair or deodorant spray could trigger an asthma attack.

Put the spray away, so we can all breathe easier.
